# Yakama Nation Agency Streets Study

The Yakama Nation has contracted with Parametrix to study the street network within the tribal administrative complex. This project aims to enhance safety and accessibility for all modes of travel within the study area. The project goals outline three key components—access, connectivity, and safety—that will guide the plan’s infrastructure recommendations.

The project will also evaluate locations along US 97 that support mobility within the study area and provide connections across the highway to the Yakama Nation Tribal School and downtown Toppenish. Potential roadway alignments in the evaluation include:

- 1 Becker Road
- 2 Proposed Robbins Road Extension
- 3 Buster Road
- 4 Ward/Gunnyon Road
